Ka Hae Aloha o Hawai'i

Aloha,

The LHG – Hawaiian Kingdom government will conduct a vigil from Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 until August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at our traditional and cultural Hale Halawai located across the ala nui from the visitor center, in an exercise of our Maoli right to protect and defend our Holiest of sites and as well, to educate our own people and the general public as to the most serious nature of our efforts to seek liberty and justice in the face of ethnic and cultural genocide in our own country.

Set-up and occupation is to begin immediately and will be ongoing until the end date given.

Denizen voter and Hawaiian Kingdom government citizenship enrollment, public education, and general information distribution will be available.

Traditional and Cultural practices including prayer, dance and chants will take place.

Access to the summit is required three times a day (morning, afternoon, and evening).

An ALOHA checkpoint will be staffed by our citizens at the cross-walk to assure that all visitors are aware of the religious and cultural practices underway as well as of the potential safety concerns on the public roadway.

Temporary structures, signage, and support facilities including but not limited to: portable toilets, tents, weather protection, food preparation, dining, and water are to be considered part of this lawful and peaceful vigil on our own lands (7) seven days a week, (24) twenty-four hours a day throughout the duration of this government approved exercise.

It is our intent to maintain a peaceful, respectful presence during this activity and we anticipate full cooperation by the State of Hawaii and the County government of the Island of Hawaii in respect of our United Nations Human Rights, for International Law, U.S. Federal Law, and State of Hawaii law which all recognize the Kanaka Maoli right to reclaim our sovereignty over our people, our assets, and our lands.


